Welcome to the first club newsletter of 2025. I'd like to call the newsletters I send out monthly Ride & Repeat, because that's really what we do!

As I assume the club's helm after Eddie Holmes' departure, I feel it's appropriate to recognize him for his amazingly impactful tenue as president. He's put his heart and soul into everything related to the club activities and greatly influenced our local cycling scene. He's truly irreplaceable. That said, I am committed to moving the club forward by organizing safe, enjoyable, and challenging events in 2025!

As a general FYI for something new, we've created a club account with **Ride With GPS**. For GCBC club members who already have an account, you can simply click the club account "join" line, and you're in. For club members who aren't already a RWGPS member, the join link will prompt you to create an account. Once you've established a presence there, you can download route navigation files and load them onto your Garmin or Wahoo head unit **or** use the RWGPS phone app to navigate routes. Be aware that when you create an account with RWGPS, there's a basic "free" version and a premium one. As a GCBC club member, you'll have access to the premium features, so the basic "free" account is all you'll need. We've just started building the route library, so it's a work in progress. Ideally, in the future, when planning and communicating rides and events, ride leaders and club members can choose an existing route or build a route and send a route link, so ride participants can preview the route and have the nav file on their head unit. We are soliciting feedback on existing routes and are open to new route suggestions! One last item related to RWGPS is that there's a club ride/event calendar there. It's very user-friendly, and I intend to keep it current and up to date. Here's the link to join-

I would appreciate feedback on this idea, and I hope to firm up this plan and get the rides and routes on the calendar very soon!

Also, Dave & Susan Ricker have graciously volunteered to lead and organize the Work-skipper/Retiree rides. In our discussion, given the popularity of these rides, we intend to do these monthly on the first Wednesday of the month, starting in February-
